### Grants 2022 - 2023

In the 2022–23 financial year one Community Grant was applied for from the Wollondilly Shire Council of \$1,000 by ex committee member Ann Bunga toward the cost of a Mosaic workshop at Buxton Hall with Sonia O'Shea.

The CASP grant Country Arts Support Project Title 'Curating an Exhibition - from Idea to Success - has been cancelled. The remaining funds will be used for a more appropriate workshop the future in consultation with Southern Tablelands Arts.
