4th 'Wollondilly Cultural Advisory Group' (WCAG) meeting was held on

Thursday 30 September 2010 at 1.00 pm in Council's Gallery @ the Council Building and was attended by WAG members Ester Kasepuu and Janet Dalton. Apart from WAG other community groups were represented. At this Cultural Advisory group meeting Bob Lester raised a request from the Mayor to look at a **Wollondilly Art Prize**. After discussion it was agreed that Elizabeth Brown from STARTS would contact Council requesting it to formally confirm its intentions and nominate an amount of funds so that the Advisory Group could work on developing a framework for a Wollondilly Art Prize.

Elizabeth spoke with WSC Community Services Manager Sarah Lees and prepared a report for Councils consideration that will be submitted to the November Council meeting.

Elizabeth's report recommends that Council:

1. Agree to host an annual Wollondilly Arts prize,
2. Agree to provide and/or secure resources to administrate the Prize, and
3. Agree to the Cultural Advisory Group developing the framework for the Prize.

Bob Lester will be putting Elizabeth's report into the template required by Council for its meetings to enable it to be considered by Councillors at the 22nd November meeting. He will provide copies of the final report at the next Advisory group meeting on 28th October at 1.00 pm in Council's Gallery @ the Council Building.

Our drawing afternoon went well. We looked at recession and how to make it happen in our drawings.

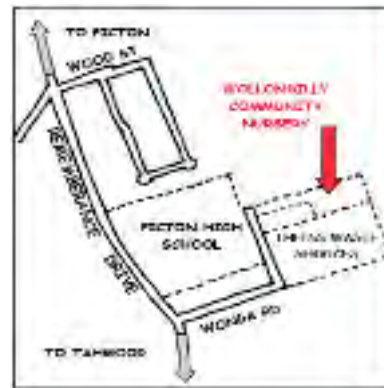
Saturday 9th October 1.00pm - 3.00pm Needle Felting with Terri
