unresolved. Recently I spoke to the General Manager Luke Johnson and we are planning a meeting to further delve into the situation.


So to all the members and friends of WAG we look forward to a good year and a creative one. Pam Berrell

The Judge Tim Storrier commented as follows:

"Using collage and montage to display a delight in patination – conveys chaotic domesticity."
